Million Kisses are one of the most vigorous, trailing begonia boliviensis on the market. The have been bred to have excellent branching and many early, large flowers. The series flowers 10 to 14 days faster than the competition, which lets growers start later and reduce bench time. Million Kisses has gorgeous retail appeal in baskets and containers, with ball Ingenuity an abundance of novelty blooms covering the freeflowering plants. Performs best in sun to partial shade in areas with low humidity. Honeymoon has quickly become a grower and consumer favorite offering a deep yellow color.
