



Julietta Pink Lisianthus

Crop time: 8 to 16 weeks

More compact and flowers one week earlier than current commercial pot lisianthus for more crops in the greenhouse and a longer selling window. The double flowers don't just offer extra beauty; this novelty also scores well in terms of lifespan.

Comments:

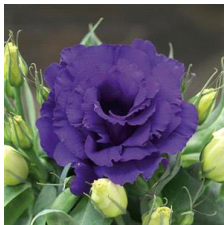
Transplant into final container when at least 2-3 pairs of true leaves are open; transplant when conditions will not stress the roots (early morning when it's cooler and less sun). Stress will result in poor growth and may also cause rosetting; do not allow plugs to become rootbound.

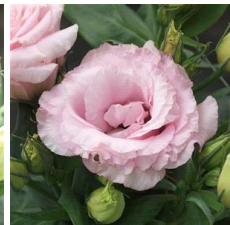

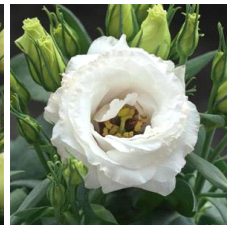
