Comments:

Need to be rooted under short days to avoid setting buds too early on in the plants life for approximately 4-5 weeks.

Fertilization (ppm N):

150 ppm, 14-4-14 after transplant. 150-200 ppm, 20-7-20 after roots have reached the edge of the pot. Feed once per week.

Comments:

Propagation: Tissue Culture Culture: Long-day flowering, reduce daylength below 11 hours to keep vegetative and bulk; increase above 14 hours to accelerate flowering. Do not over water. Early Summer Culture: Planting week 14 to 18 Plant plugs direct into 3 to 5-liter containers outside. It is possible to go through a liner stage but plants grow so rapidly that this is not required. Protection may be required, depending on your local conditions. Expect a crop time of 13 to 14 weeks from planting to flowering. Late Summer Culture: Planting week 20 to 24 Plant plugs direct into 3 to 5-liter containers outside. Expect a crop time of 10 to 11 weeks from planting to flowering.
